MELOCALIZACIÓN

It is a tool to verify the correspondence between events and the astrological charts.

In order to obtain reliable results with the use of this tool, it is necessary to know and keep in mind some specific rules of use of the technique itself.

The development of this tool began at the beginning of the 90s with a simple question from Dr. Daniel Zuluaga r.i.p. who during the study of primary directions asked: "If I start from a zero point and walk on a line (ecliptic) 10 steps and then I return 10 steps, I should reach the zero point; if I do it with the positions of the planets in a Radix, why do I only get to the same point with the Sun, NN and cusps? The answer is ... The answer is yes" because the other planets have ecliptic latitude and declination. Then we have a time error when we progress...

In this way we started a search process with the calculation tools suggested by Nelson Page, Vendel Polich and Alexander Mar and the participation of many minds that with their questions, suggestions and findings contribute to the user manual of the Oblique Longitude.

After several years of verifications and after reading THE BOOK OF KNOWLEDGE and we understood that the source of knowledge is Unique, Universal, Eternal and that our wonderful brain can at a certain moment connect to that source and drink; that is, no one owns or possesses the absolute truth and that this is discovered on a day-to-day basis and that although who writes these lines manifests itself in a physical body and with a specific name, it is the sum of the different we and only acts as a Speaker, in the construction of a Sunny morning. Bearing this premise in mind, we coined the term MELOCALIZER to name the Radix card raised for a given moment using the planetary positions in Oblique Longitude and that allows us to go one step further in searching, the Total correspondence between the Astrological forecast and the time it happens .

Regardless of which technique or radix calculation system you are used to using (Sideral, tropical, topocentric, etc.) with entering the Melocalization

module, the Meridian Program shows on the screen the double graph of the Radix under study, with the positions in Length Oblique in the inner wheel and the planets in transit for that moment and place, for the study and judgment.


The OBLIQUE LONGITUDE (LO) of a celestial body (for example of a point of the ecliptic) is the distance, measured on the celestial "ecliptic", between the vernal point and that point of the celestial equator that ascends at the same moment as the celestial body in question.

It has the characteristic that being a point on the ecliptic line has no ecliptic latitude, just as the AO / DO don't have declines are temporary points or expressed as a function of time, that allows all calculations to be unified to positions expressed in function weather.


In fact, the use of LO is the next step given later - and contributing to Polich-Page-Rosas and it has been possible to "advance" thanks to the contribution of many minds and the technological possibilities of the Astrological programs.

To complement and implement the use and application of LO or for what they serve, the following is presented: Full moons seen from traditional Astrology set one hour of the exact Moon / Sun opposition. This position is the same for any place on the planet- With the Tool that uses LO (Melocalizador) we have different times for each site, in correspondence to the real event, not in all parts of the planet it is seen shadow of an Eclipse.

Below are the two letters for the Full Moon immediately preceding (in this case, it was simultaneous with LO) the Hurricane on New York on October 29, 2012.



As it is of common use to see the lunations, we look for if there is a planetary position on the main axes and for the case of the tropical card with traditional planetary positions we only find the wheel of fortune.
